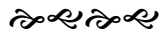


Marriage Procedures for St. Vincent & The Grenadines

Visitors who wish to marry in The Grenadines must be residents in St. Vincent and The Grenadines for one (1) clear days (*the arrival day is not included*) before attaining the marriage license.

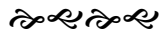
Upon arrival to Canouan each guest is presented with a customs and immigration form. This form is needed as proof of residency when applying for the marriage license in St. Vincent.



The Governor General's License, which is a Special License, must be obtained at the Ministry of Justice, Kingstown, St. Vincent.

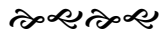
It is not obtainable elsewhere.

Father Garroway is the preferred Justice of The Peace on Canouan to perform civil wedding ceremonies.



Applicants must produce their passports.

Where an applicant was previously married it is necessary to produce a certificate of dissolution of the marriage or if widowed a death certificate in English.



A Marriage Officer, who has been duly appointed to perform such ceremonies, or the Register of the High Court, must perform the ceremony. For those wishing to be married at the Raffles Resort the wedding documents must be filled out completely and brought to the minister of your choice.
